

August 8, 2018

Council Member Barrett called the meeting to order at 6:20 pm. Member Thacker was out of town. In attendance were Attorney Blazey, Marshall Drew, Winfred Brock and Richard Mangel.

Minutes of the July meeting were signed following a vote of 2-yeas and 0-nays to approve them as written.

Attorney Blazey and Council Members reviewed the Town's ordinance regulating off-road vehicles. Blazey read aloud portions of the State statute. After some discussion and at the suggestion of Council Members, Blazey agreed to redraft the Town's ordinance to bring it up to State statute. He anticipates having a draft ordinance ready for consideration at the September meeting.

Barrett reported Sean Muldoon has resigned from his part-time employment position with the Town effective immediately. Council Members, following a previous interview, and on a motion by Barrett, second by Ellis and a vote of 2-yeas and 0-nays, agreed to hire Michael Seger part-time at \$12.00 per hour. Seger will get in touch with Brock on Thursday to go over his job duties and the equipment he is expected to operate.

Barrett gave a brief Park Board report, stating a new entry to the tennis court has been agreed upon. Improvements are expected to be completed by the fest. Barrett estimated landscaping materials at \$1,500.00. Motion was made by Ellis to approve the purchase. Second was made by Barrett. Motion carried by a 2-yeas and 0-nays vote.

Brock reported the Town is in need of more sand. He was instructed to order it for delivery before the winter season.


Barrett and Drew bought up an issue with apparent stains on the refurbished floor of the fire station. Barrett added Kenny Peacock said it requires a coating of commercial wax.


Clerk-Treasurer Schuetter reported he will be meeting with the Department of Local Finance field agent tomorrow morning and will be setting the dates for a public hearing and adoption of the 2019 budget. He will report back to the Council. Barrett requested he avoid the week of October 1st thru 5th. Schuetter suggested the October Council meeting be set for October 10th.

Schuetter presented two late arriving claims from Fisher Electric and Econo Signs that were not on the claim register. Member Barrett made a motion to approve the claims presented and have them listed on the register. Second was made by Ellis. Motion carried by vote of 2-yeas and 0-nays.

Motion was then made by Ellis to approve the claim register as presented and seconded by Barrett. Motion carried by a vote of 2-yeas and 0-nays. The claim register was signed.

There being no further business before the Council, Ellis made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Second was made by Barrett. Motion again carried by a 2-0 vote and the meeting was adjourned.
